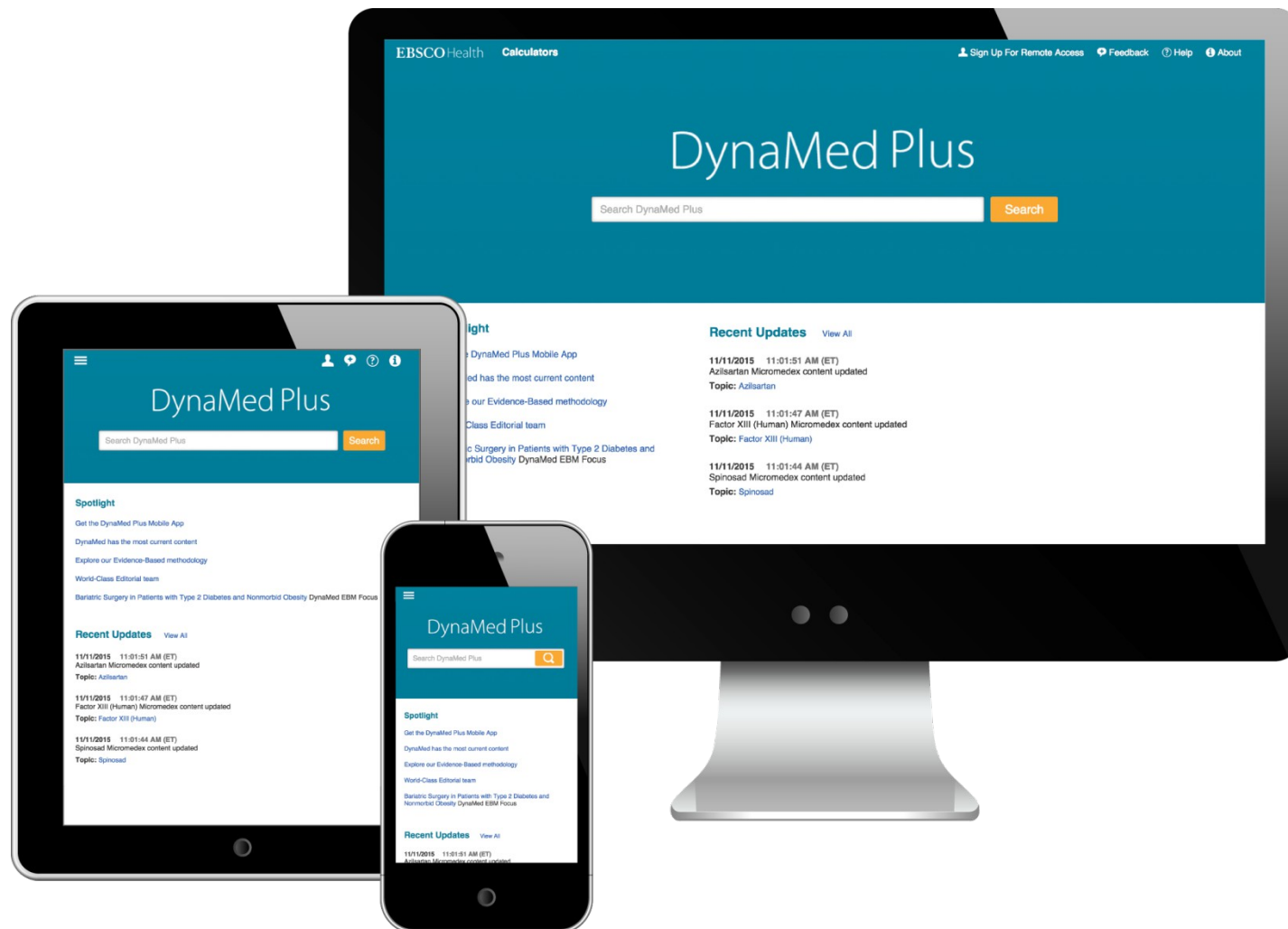

Pulmonary embolism (PE)

 CME

Etiology and Pathogenesis / Causes

Causes

- deep vein thrombosis (DVT) is most common cause (venous thromboembolism [VTE])^(1, 2, 3, 4)
 - lower extremity DVT most common source⁽⁴⁾
 - pelvic DVT less common source⁽⁴⁾
- less frequent causes
 - septic embolism⁽¹⁾
 - septic pulmonary emboli most commonly associated with right-heart endocarditis, especially in IV drug users
 - other sources of septic emboli include infected indwelling catheters, infected pacemaker wires, peripheral septic thrombophlebitis
 - venous air embolism
 - may occur as accidental introduction of air (or exogenous gas) during operative procedure⁽¹⁾
 - vaginal manipulation reported in 2 cases of obstetric air embolism (Obstet Gynecol 2008 Feb;111(2 Pt 2):487, Obstet Gynecol 2008 Feb;111(2 Pt 2):489), correction can be found in Obstet Gynecol 2008 Sep;112(3):710, editorial can be found in Obstet Gynecol 2008 Feb;111(2 Pt 2):481, commentary can be found in Obstet Gynecol 2008 Jun;111(6):1444
 - fat embolism⁽¹⁾
 - embolization of marrow fat with pelvic or long bone fractures
 - iatrogenic causes may include
 - placement of knee or hip prostheses
 - endomedullary nailing
 - lipid or propofol infusion

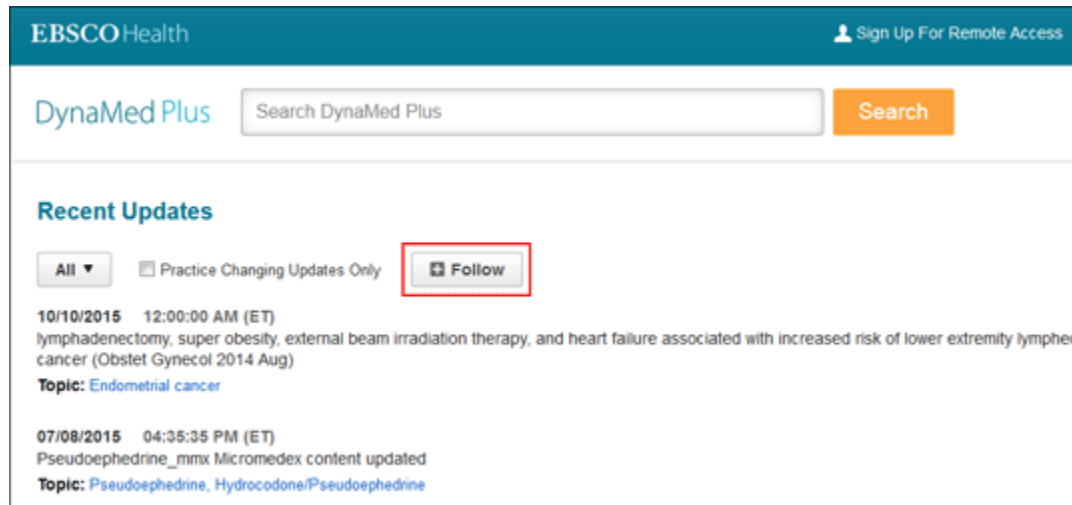

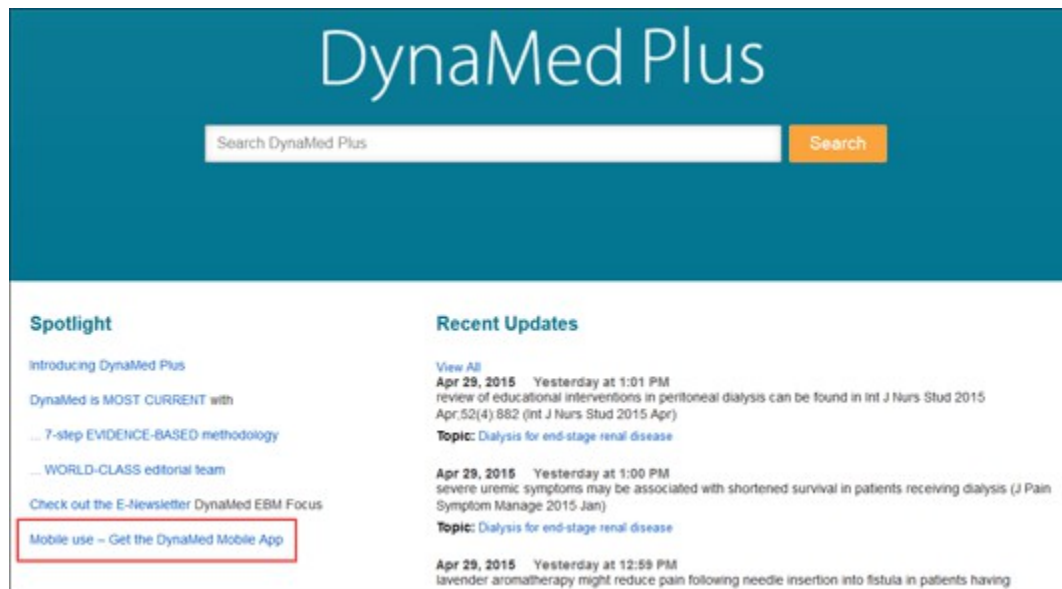
